



ST. LOUIS CHAPTER – DARTHE F. NAY SCHOLARSHIP 2008-2009

The St. Louis Chapter of the ASWA is accepting applications for the Darthe F. Nay Scholarship for the 2008-2009 academic year. The purpose of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to women who are pursuing their goals of higher education, with preference to students enrolled in an evening or weekend program. Scholarships of either \$500 or \$1,000 will be awarded.

The following summarizes the basic criteria for the Darthe Nay Scholarship:

1. Applicant must be majoring in accounting.
2. At the completion of the fall 2007 academic term, applicant must have completed 60 semester hours (or the equivalent) towards a degree and completed at least 12 semester hours (or the equivalent) of accounting courses.
3. Applicant must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (B average).
4. Consideration will be given to financial need and leadership potential.
5. The scholarship is to support the costs of the recipient's third, fourth or fifth year of education.

APPLICATION PROCESS

All applications must be received no later than January 31, 2008. Only completed application packets will be considered for a scholarship award. All information is held in strict confidence. Successful applicants will be notified by March 1, 2008.

APPLICATION PACKET

An application packet consists of one (1) original and three (3) copies of the following materials.

1. A completed, typed application form.
2. Seventy-five (75) word essay from the applicant describing career goals and objectives, the impact the applicant wants to have on the accounting world and what the applicant most likes about accounting.
3. Academic transcript from college or university, showing academic performance and credit hours obtained. Note that an official transcript is required with the original materials; copies of the official transcript are acceptable for the three copies of the materials.
4. One letter of recommendation from an accounting professor or a faculty advisor.
